Scope (products)	Timber and timber products (Annex 1)	Cattle, cocoa, coffee, oil palm, soya and wood and relevant product that contain, or have been fed with or have been made using relevant commodities		
Focus and main requirements	Legality Produced in compliance with applicable legislation in the country of origin	 Legality and deforestation free not produced on land subject to deforestation of forest degradation after 31st December 2020 Produced in accordance with the relevant legislation of the country of origin Covered by a due diligence statement (to be submitted to the EU information system before

	EUTR	EUDR
Actors and their obligations	Operator = places timber or timber products on the EU market → Due Diligence	Operator = places relevant commodities and products on the EU market or exports them from the EU market → Due Diligence
	Trader = sells or buys on the EU market timber or timber products already placed on the EU market → Traceability (record keeping)	Trader = within the supply chain, other than the operator, that makes available on the EU market relevant commodities and products. 2 cases: Non-SME → Due Diligence
		SME → Traceability (record keeping)



















































WHY?
