TASK 1.1

*"To compile an **inventory of innovative mechanisms (IM)** to support the provision of forest ecosystem services (FES) across Europe"*

- **INSTRUMENT:** different types of policy tools that allow to implement policies so as to reach their aims and objectives.
- **MECHANISM:** goes more in detail than simply "instrument", paying attention to the components, their interaction and the process through which this interaction is built.
- **Examples:**








 **TASK 1.1**


